


Increasing literacy by increasing access to books and information

An Investment in Young Minds:

Only 34% of Bartow County's children read proficiently by the end of the third grade. Children who do not read well at this critical juncture are **four times more likely to drop out of school**. This means that 66% of our children are at high-risk. These risks are compounded for children in lowincome families. An introduction to books and being read to at home prior to beginning school is the single most important factor influencing a child's early educational success. Early literacy changes lives!
