




## \$2,003 IN TWO WEEKS!

With your help, we raised \$2,003 for Giving Tuesday! Those funds will be used primarily to purchase books to give away to the children we serve in Bartow County. Thank you for your generosity and support!







#### WE ARE OFTEN ASKED: "HOW ARE YOU ABLE TO GIVE AWAY SO MANY BOOKS?"

Doesn't that get expensive? The Bookmobile uses both new and gently used books for its programs. Gently used books are donated by generous members of our community, as are some new books. In addition, we purchase new books in bulk from various literacy partners. Most new books are purchased from First Book. In their own words, "First Book is a non-profit social enterprise that provides new books and educational resources – at low cost – to schools and programs serving children in need, ages 0-18." First Book "makes brand-new, high-quality books" available to their members through agreements with partners in the publishing industry. The only requirement of members is that all books purchased be given away for free to children ages 0-18.

By leveraging our partnership with First Book and others such as Scholastic Literacy Partners, we purchase brand new books at an average of only \$1.49 each.
